INSIDE INFORMATION ANNOUNCEMENT POTENTIAL DATA SECURITY INCIDENT

This announcement is made by Top Education Group Ltd (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) under Rule 13.09(2) of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities (the “**Listing Rules**”) on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”) and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined in the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

On 5 August 2026, the Group became aware of a news article which reported that a threat actor claimed on an underground forum to possess certain records allegedly relating to students enrolled in education programmes operated by the Group, and purported to offer access to, or sale of, such records (the “**Alleged Incident**”).

Upon becoming aware of the Alleged Incident, the Group immediately commenced an investigation to assess whether there has been any unauthorised access to, or leakage of, personal data as alleged and, if so, the nature and extent of such unauthorised access or data leakage, the categories of data potentially affected, the underlying cause of the Alleged Incident and the security of the Group’s systems and servers. The Group will take appropriate further actions as the investigation progresses.

The Group has reported the Alleged Incident to the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency and the Australian Cyber Security Centre. Subject to seeking further legal advice, the Group will take appropriate actions and inform other relevant authorities as necessary to ensure that all of our obligations are met and will proactively cooperate and assist with any inquiries or investigations. The Group is committed to protecting its students’ information and their privacy by regularly reviewing and strengthening its information security and cybersecurity measures.

The Group will continue to assess the operational and financial impact, if any, of the Alleged Incident. Based on the information currently available to the Group, the Alleged Incident has not caused any material disruption to the Group’s operations as at the date of this announcement.

The information contained in this announcement is based on the Group's preliminary assessment of the information currently available to it. Shareholders and potential investors of the Company are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.
