INSIDE INFORMATION ANNOUNCEMENT UPDATE ON DATA SECURITY INCIDENT

This announcement is made by Top Education Group Ltd (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) under Rule 13.09(2) of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities (the “**Listing Rules**”) on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”) and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined in the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

Reference is made to the announcement of the Company dated 6 August 2026 (the “**Announcement**”). Unless otherwise defined, capitalized terms used in this announcement shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Announcement.

As stated in the Announcement, the Group commenced an investigation and engaged cyber security and forensic experts to assess the extent of unauthorised access to or leakage of personal data, if any, arising from the Alleged Incident (the “**Investigation**”). Upon becoming aware of the Alleged Incident, the Group had also immediately taken steps to identify the possible points of unauthorised access and took appropriate action to sever the Threat Actor’s connection and access to the SMS.

Based on the findings of the Investigation, an unauthorised third party (the “**Threat Actor**”) had obtained access to the Company’s Student Management System (“**SMS**”) through compromised credentials of a staff member of the Group. Certain personal information (such as identity and contact information and enrolment information etc.) stored in the SMS may have been subject to unauthorised access or disclosure. The Group estimates that approximately 24,934 individuals, comprising prospective, current, or former students and staff members of the Group located or previously located in Australia, have been affected by the Alleged Incident.

The Group has reported the Alleged Incident to the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency, the Australian Cyber Security Centre, the Australian Government Department of Education and the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner.

The Group has notified the affected individuals to alert them about the Alleged Incident and the potential exposure of the personal information as a result of the Alleged Incident, and provided further information on the steps to be taken to protect against potential misuse of their personal information and other support.

The Group has also implemented additional cybersecurity measures, including but not limited to resetting passwords for all staff accounts, enhanced user authentication controls, implemented additional access restrictions and other monitoring measures designed to detect and prevent further unauthorised access. The Group is committed to protecting the personal information and data privacy of all students and staff, and to defend against any similar incidents in the future by continuously strengthening its information system security measures.

Shareholders and potential investors of the Company are cautioned not to unduly rely on such information and are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.
